1. Extension and developer

Consent Control for Nicepage is a Joomla extension developed and distributed by:

Consent Control for Nicepage is an independently developed extension for websites created with Nicepage and operated with Joomla. It is not affiliated with, sponsored by or endorsed by Nicepage.

2. GNU General Public License

Consent Control for Nicepage is free software licensed under the GNU General Public License, version 2 or, at your option, any later version (GPL-2.0-or-later).

Under the GNU GPL, you may use, copy, study, modify and redistribute the extension in accordance with the terms of that licence. No product plan, licence key, download credential or service entitlement adds restrictions to the rights granted by the GNU GPL.

The complete GNU GPL version 2 licence text is included in every installation package as LICENSE.txt.

The GNU GPL licence applies to the extension's PHP program code. Individual third-party materials or assets, if present, may be subject to their respective compatible licence notices. Their permitted use is not restricted through a product activation.

3. Paid access to official distribution services

Payment is not required to keep the installed extension functioning. The selected product plan determines only access to services provided by the developer, including:

- official installation-package downloads;
- automatic updates supplied through Joomla's update system;
- access to releases published while the applicable service entitlement is active;
- any support or other services explicitly included in the selected plan.

An absent, invalid, expired, exhausted, revoked or temporarily unverifiable service credential does not disable the installed consent, resource-control, configuration or administration functionality.

4. Plan limits

References to a website limit, such as Single-Site, Professional or Agency access, describe how many active Joomla installations may simultaneously receive official downloads, automatic updates and included services using the purchaser's credentials.

These limits do not restrict the purchaser's rights under the GNU GPL to run, inspect, modify or redistribute copies of the software.

Official download keys, update credentials, activation tokens and account credentials are personal service credentials. They may not be sold, published or shared with unauthorised third parties. This restriction applies to access to the developer's servers and services, not to the GPL-licensed software itself.

5. Continued use

An installed version may continue to be used after access to official downloads, updates or included services ends. Ending a service entitlement does not impose a technical restriction on the installed extension.

For security and compatibility, users are responsible for keeping Joomla, PHP and all installed extensions maintained and for installing available security updates from an authorised source.

6. Updates and support

Only updates and services explicitly described on the product page or during checkout are included. The availability of future releases is not guaranteed beyond releases actually published while the product is actively maintained and the applicable service entitlement permits access.

Unless a product plan explicitly states otherwise, the product is provided as a self-service extension with installation documentation. Individual website configuration, legal review, privacy audits and custom development are not included.

7. Technical and legal responsibility

Consent Control for Nicepage is a technical configuration and resource-control tool. It does not provide legal advice and does not by itself guarantee compliance with the GDPR, ePrivacy rules or any other law.

Users remain responsible for:

- identifying the services and data processing used on their websites;
- assigning appropriate consent categories;
- providing accurate privacy and cookie information;
- configuring the original Nicepage consent dialog correctly;
- testing the final website configuration; and
- obtaining legal advice where necessary.

8. Warranty

The extension is distributed in the hope that it will be useful, but without any warranty, to the extent permitted by applicable law. The warranty disclaimer and limitation provisions of the GNU GPL apply to the GPL-licensed software.

Any mandatory statutory consumer rights remain unaffected.

Nicepage is a trademark of its respective owner. The name is used only to describe the extension's intended compatibility. Joomla and the Joomla logo are trademarks of Open Source Matters, Inc. The use of these names does not imply sponsorship or endorsement.
